## **NTSRI Scholarship Rules:**

- NTSRI will award 3 scholarships. The scholarships valued at \$1000.00 will be paid directly to the college after the completion of the first semester. The recipient must submit their first semester grades to the committee with a brief summary of the first semester. A minimum of a 2.5 GPA must be obtained to receive the scholarship.
- The scholarship is available to any member of NTSRI who is seeking post-secondary education in the fall of 2022. Students must begin college in the fall of 2022 to receive the award.
- The recipient may have won the scholarship before, if they present the scholarship committee with proof of grades during the time that they received the scholarship.
- The applicant or their parent must be a current member of NTSRI and have been a member in 2021 and have their 2022 dues paid by the application deadline of April 15, 2022. In addition, a member must have at least 2 sheep registered with the organization both years to be eligible to receive the scholarship.
- A copy of your resume should be included in the application.

***The application deadline is April 15, 2022 and will be considered  
late if received after this date.***

The Scholarship selection committee will review the applications and announce the winner(s)  
May 12th -14th, 2022 at the Ohio Showcase Sale in Greenville, OH if possible.

- A. NTSRI will award 2 scholarships. Two \$500.00 scholarships will be paid directly to the college after the completion of the first semester. The recipient must submit their first semester grades to the committee with a brief summary of the first semester. A minimum of a 2.5 GPA must be obtained to receive the scholarship.
- B. The scholarship is available to any member of NTSRI who is seeking post-secondary education in the fall of 2022. Students must begin college in the fall of 2022 to receive the award.
- C. The recipient may have won the scholarship before, provided that they present the scholarship committee with proof of grades during the time that they received the scholarship.
- D. The applicant or their parent must be a current member of NTSRI, and have been a member in 2021 and have their 2022 dues paid by the application deadline of April 15, 2022. In addition a member must have at least 2 sheep registered with the organization both years to be eligible to receive the scholarship.
- E. A copy of your resume should be included in the application.
- F. The application deadline is April 15, 2022 and will be considered late if received after this date.

- G. The Scholarship selection committee will review the applications and announce the winner(s) prior to the Ohio Showcase Sale in Greenville, Ohio.
